- Does the project address a significant community need?
- Does the project serve disadvantaged people and/or communities (Ex. People with a physical or mental disability, low socioeconomic status, immigrants, people of color, women, LGBTQ)?
- Does the project fit with the Community Care Fund theme?

**Project Potential**

- Is there a plan for attracting and enrolling participants?
- Is the timeline for project implementation reasonable? (Funding cannot be awarded for projects that will be completed before October 2017)

**Partnerships, Collaborations & Coordination**

- Is the organization working in coordination and/or collaboration on the project with specific organizations in the same or related fields?

**Outcomes & Impact**

- Are the outcomes realistic?
- Are the outcomes meaningful and impactful?

**Funding Request & Budget**

- Is the request for cost of services reasonable?
- Is the funding request (the expenses that would be funded by CCF) clear and aligned with the goals of the project?

**Other Considerations Review Teams May Discuss**

- Will this project happen without funding?
- Will this project happen with partial funding from CCF?
- Is the organization likely to get funding from other sources?
- Is the organization likely to get enough funding needed to make the project happen?
- Does the project build capacity of or grow the organization?
- Does the project address the root cause of the issue or offer systemic solutions?
- Does the project take a new approach to an issue?
- Does the project leverage resources through special partnerships?
- Is the project/organization "the only game in town"?
- Are there other programs or organizations in the Triangle that could serve as a preferred provider to tackle the issue?
- Are there significant long-term or indirect community benefits?
- Is there appropriate closure, phase out or follow up?
- If this is an ongoing project, is a plan specified to operate the program after this funding period?

- How much funding do you recommend for this project?
- What are your reasons for this funding recommendation?
